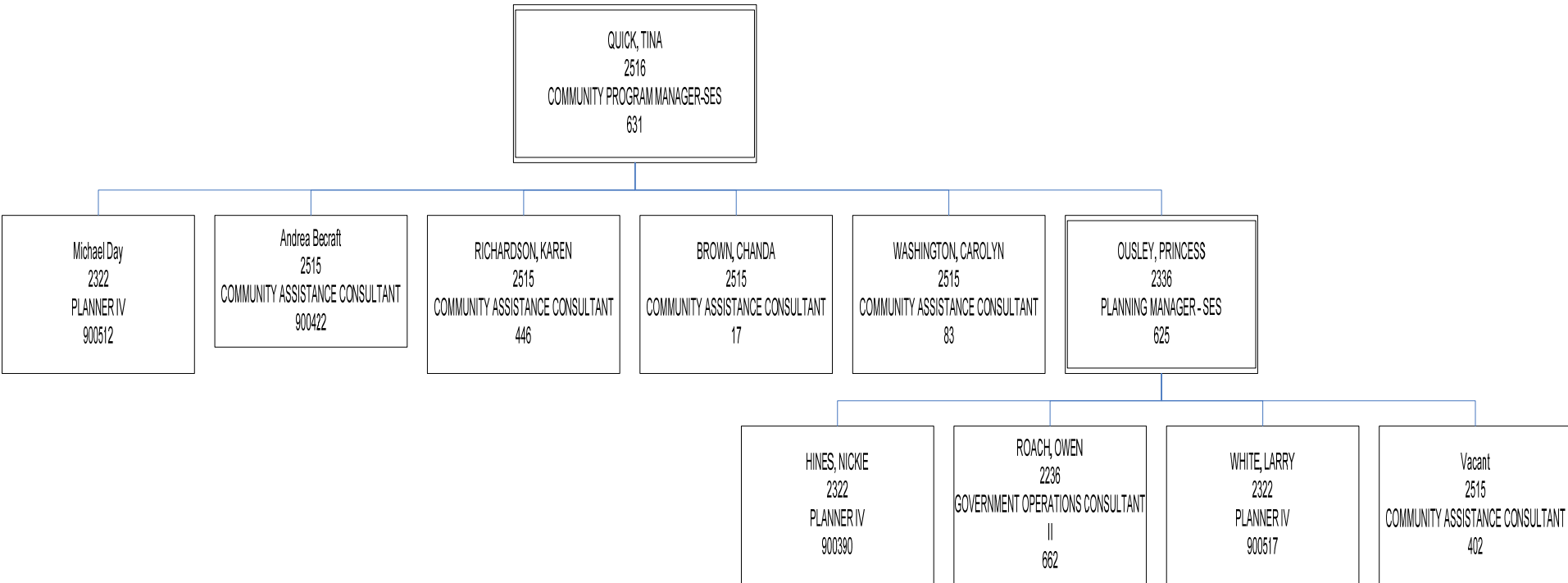

- **5-10 key goals for fiscal year 2009-2010**
 1. All DHS reports will be submitted on time.
 2. All DHS related applications will be submitted on time.
 3. A minimum of one funding conference will be held but not limited to two, contingent upon DHS's release of grant guidance and awards.
 4. DHS sub grant agreements will be sent to approved recipients within 45 days of receipt of grant award.
 5. 100% of sub grantees will receive desk-top monitoring.
 6. Reduction in audit findings

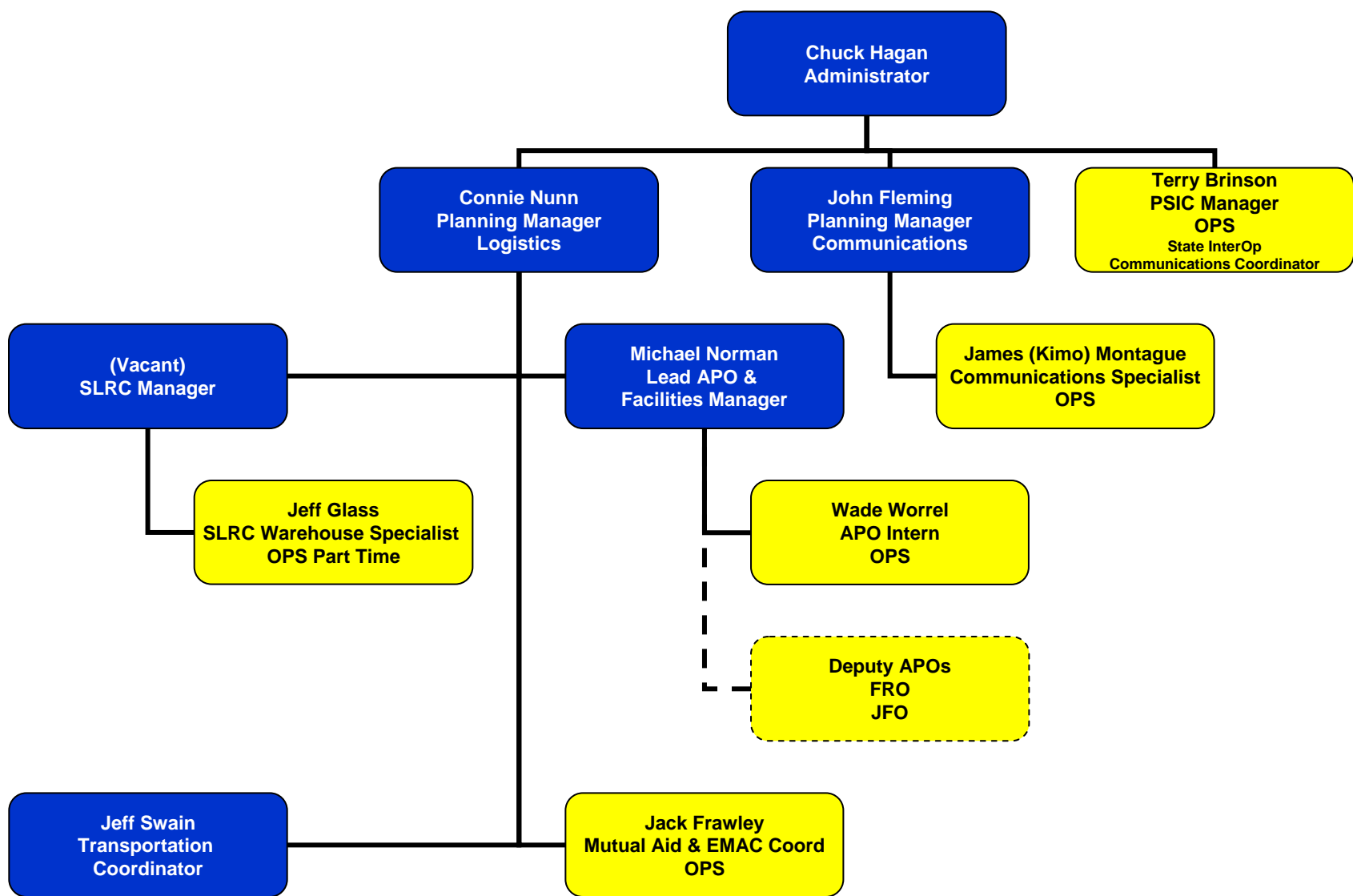
LOGISTICS SECTION

- Oversees coordination of log support to emergency ops
- Sources, negotiates & manages DEM Support Contracts
- Manages the State Resource Management Network, SLRC, Property, Fleet, Mutual Aid, & EMAC
- Responsible for maintaining the State Logistics Plan
- Works with Bureaus to establish Division wide standards and specifications for equipment and system purchases
- Supports Emergency Management Logistics Training at the State and County levels
- Manages the Division Communication Programs

5-10 KEY GOALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010

- Expand DEM Log personnel on IMT's, the SEOC & in the field by 6 personnel
- Recruit/train at least 18 additional logs staff fm counties for 3 Logistics Management Teams
- Expand storage capacity at the SLRC using "Roll in Racks" storage technology
- Expand the scope and responsibilities of the Communications Unit
- Continue to provide Logs/Comms tech and contracting assistance to the counties.
- Expand the number of Logistics Training Courses offered through the state.
- Secure additional Mobilization Sites in central and south Florida to expand critical field locations.
- Consolidate all property management for the entire Division

- Manage and conduct Statewide Hurricane Shelter Survey and Retrofit Program & Report
- Coordinators for Prep and Distribution of the Statewide Emergency Shelter Plan
- Division Liaison for Development & Implementation of Public Hurricane Shelter Criteria, Codes and Standard

- **Serve as Infrastructure Branch Staff of the State EOC**

- **Project manager for much of HB7121 – EOCs and emergency generators**

- **5-10 key goals for fiscal year 2009-2010**
 - Improve hurricane shelter survey productivity
 - Identify funding source and contract for hurricane shelter survey consultant services
 - Publish 2009 Shelter Retrofit Report & 2010 Statewide Emergency Shelter Plan
 - Collaborate with Preparedness/Natural Hazards Planning and Dept. of Health staff to better quantify special needs shelter space demand
 - Collaborate with EOG & DEP to better define catastrophic disaster fuel demands

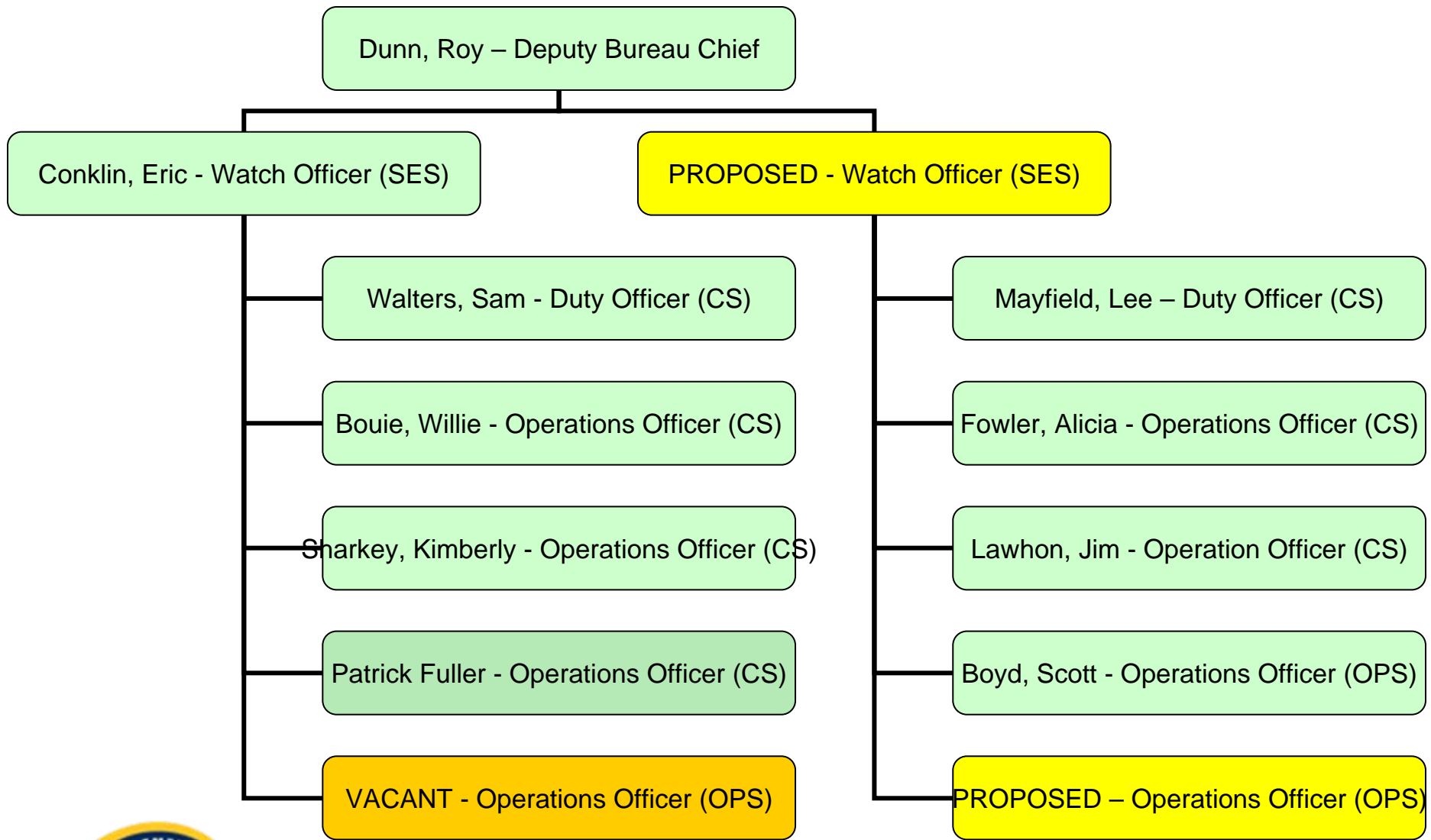


- Operations Section monitors day to day incidents, activities, and events within the State of Florida that could require a State response, as well as the operational readiness of the State Emergency Operations Center.
- The State Watch Office is the tactical center of the State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC), manned and equipped to collect, present, manage, evaluate and disseminate information for the use of the State Emergency Response Team (SERT) Chief, State Coordinating Officer (SCO), jurisdictions and control agencies.

- 5-10 key goals for fiscal year 2009-2010
 1. Fully staffed with less than ten (10%) percent attrition with Full Time Employees (FTE) per year.
 2. All Operations staff fully trained in new Operations/Watch Office minimum classes
 3. All Operations equipment full mission capable with no more than 30 days at partial mission capable status
 4. Five (5) minute no-notice notification time using SERT ALERT
 5. Ten (10) minute no-notice notification Flash Report
 6. Ninety (90%) Timeliness & Accuracy in Daily Situation Reports
 7. Upgraded Incident Recorder & Notification System
 8. Performance Reward Program
