Today accomplishments/ notes

We had an involved discussion about the following aspects of this section (6.1):

- The need to re-evaluate current SHMPAT tasks as related to the maintenance section
- To re-evaluate language referring to "annual" update-- not seen as necessary given that the entire plan is updated every three years
- Interim plan updates should take place only as needed, not based upon a timeframe
- We should use the SWOT analysis method to determine what needs to be revised in the plan
- The SHMPAT needs to meet regularly (but not necessarily 4X every year) in order to network, retain viability, assess mitigation progress, take advantage of mitigation funding opportunities through local actions or State initiatives, receive DEM updates, and examine target issues
- After updated plan approval, SHMPAT could meet 2X annually for the first 2 years, then more often to accomplish update work in third year...

Next team meeting's work

- Thoroughly review Section 6 (Plan Maintenance) and email or fax comments/ revision suggestions to Marybeth Groff, who will assimilate
- Discuss these revisions at the next Planning Team meeting

Things that should be addressed at the next meeting of the entire SHMPAT (April 14, 2009)
