► Compliance w/ Federal Laws & Regulations

- If there's a law, you have to comply with it.
- Federal & State
- The Plan will update to comply w/ legal changes

Florida State Hazard Mitigation Plan Update Regulations

- ▶ 44 CFR 201.4 (a) The mitigation plan is the demonstration of the State's commitment to reduce risks from natural hazards and serves as a guide for State decision makers as they commit resources to reducing the effects of natural hazards.
- ▶ 44CFR 201.4(d) *Review and updates.* Plan must be reviewed and revised to reflect changes in development, progress in statewide mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities and resubmitted for approval to the appropriate Regional Director every three years. ... We also encourage a State to review its plan in the post-disaster timeframe to reflect changing priorities but it is not required.
- ▶ 44CFR 13.11(3)(d) *Amendments.* A State will amend a plan whenever necessary to reflect: (1) New or revised Federal statutes or regulations or (2) material change in any State law, organization, policy, or State agency operation. The State will obtain approval for the amendment and its effective date but need submit for approval only the amended portions of the plan.
