The 2025-2026 Opt-In Period is LIVE!

Through August 31st, 2024, you will have the opportunity to Opt-In or renew your Opt-In to the Florida Recovery Obligation Calculation (F-ROC) program once again *for free* upon completing an eLearning course and submitting a 'Participation Request and Renewal Form'. *If you are renewing* with F-ROC this Opt-In period, the eLearning is not required.

Opt-In benefits include, but are not limited to:

- 1. The ability to recover up to 85% of funds up-front post-event for the 2025/2026 storm season.
- 2. The opportunity to review policies and procedures ahead of time to avoid deobligations.
- 3. Access to FDEM's expertise as it relates to the identification of risks and associated abatement plans.
